Ninth Grade Health Requirements for School Entry 2023-2024

Per Board of Education Policy 7:100, all students must meet the health requirements as outlined by the Illinois Department of Public Health. All requirements must be in place before school entry. For health and safety reasons, students that are non-compliant will be excluded from school on or before October 15th of the current school year. New students who register after October 15th of the current school year shall have 30 days following registration to comply with the health examination and immunization regulations.

- Physical exams dated on or after August 16, 2022 will be accepted and are due on the first day of school. Physicians licensed to practice medicine in all of its branches, licensed advanced practice registered nurses, or licensed physician assistants shall be responsible for the performance of the physical exam.
 - **Health Examination** conducted within one year prior to the date of entry, is required and on Certificate of Health Examination form.
 - **Health History Section** must be completed and signed by the parent or legal guardian. *This is required.*
 - **Diabetes Risk Questionnaire** is completed if BMI for age is >85%.

Please note: IESA/IHSA sports physical forms MAY NOT be used as the required school health exam. * However, a physical exam completed on the "Certificate of Child Health" form may be used as a sports physical.

- 2. Immunizations: Month/day/year and correct number of doses at the correct intervals must be verified by a healthcare provider. Immunizations are required as follows for ninth grade entry:
 - **DTaP:** 3 or more doses of DTaP, at appropriate intervals, with the last dose being a booster and given on or after the 4th Birthday.
 - **Tdap:** 1 dose of Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) required for students in ninth grade.
 - POLIO: 4 doses with the last dose administered on or after the 4th birthday.
 - MMR: 2 doses; 1 dose on or after the first birthday, second dose given at least 28 days later.
 - VARICELLA (Chicken Pox): 2 doses; 1 dose on or after the first birthday, second dose given at least 28 days later, or proof of chickenpox disease.
 - **Hepatitis B:** Three doses of Hepatitis B administered at appropriate intervals.
 - Meningitis: 1 dose of meningitis vaccine given on or after 11th birthday
- **3. Dental Examination** is due on or before May 15, 2024. Dental exams dated on or after November 15, 2022 will be accepted.
